

# Update on the process of filing and paying the Withholding Tax through the new Dhareeba portal

# Tax Alert | 20 October 2020

## **Background**

The General Tax Authority ("GTA") launched the new tax administration system – Dhareeba effective from 1 October 2020. As of 1 October 2020 submissions on the old Tax Administration System ("TAS") were ceased. As a result of the launch of the new system, the GTA's banking details have changed and the old bank details are no longer to be used for purpose of withholding tax ("WHT") payments.

#### **Key aspects:**

- New WHT format according to Dhareeba portal's specifications
- New payment methods available as listed below:
  - o Credit or Debit Card (QAR 50,000 limit)

The new Dhareeba portal allows the taxpayer to select Debit and Credit Card payment options, which would then take the taxpayer to a digital gateway where the card details are filled.

#### o Bank Transfer

The Bank Transfer method requires a Payment Reference Number ("PRN") to be included at the time of initiating the payment of tax/penalty. Please note that

the PRN is only generated once the WHT statement has been uploaded and saved in the portal. Please see new bank details below:

## Direct Payment

When selecting this payment method the taxpayer is required to access its Bank portal to initiate the payment. Please note that only QNB, CBQ and Doha Bank are listed in Dhareeba portal as the banks allowing direct transfer.

- The portal only allows for the WHT statement to be submitted once the payment is reflected/recorded on Dhareeba portal
- We would advise the taxpayers to start the WHT submission process earlier than usual
  to provide sufficient time for the payment to reflect in the taxpayer's account before the
  deadline as the above listed payment methods may take time to reflect in the taxpayers
  profile on Dhareeba portal.
- We would like to highlight that in case a payment is not credited to the GTA's account on or before 15th of the month, a penalty for late payment may apply. To avoid any interpretation risk from the GTA, we advise taxpayers to proceed, preferably, with the WHT payment at least 3-4 days before the deadline of 15<sup>th</sup> of the month.
